What is a Child Contact Centre?

A Child Contact Centre is a safe and neutral environment where the child is the most important person. The child remains at the centre of the entire process.

They are given the opportunity to spend time with the parent or family members with whom they do not usually live.

YMCA Bournemouth Child Contact Centres have a variety of venues offering age appropriate facilities and resources to encourage interaction.



We offer three levels of service*:

- Supported Contact
- Supervised Contact
- Handover

Supported Contact

Supported Contact offers children the opportunity to develop their relationship with the parent or relative they do not live with

This can be in a group or on a 1-1 basis, depending on the child's best interest. Staff and volunteers are on hand to offer advice, guidance and activities.

We offer an impartial service and aim to work with both parties to ensure a positive experience for the child.



Supervised Contact

Supervised Contact offers children the chance to spend time with their parent or relative, where there has been, or continues to be, a concern regarding the adult's care for the child.

Observation notes are taken throughout the session and are provided to the referring agent.

Handover

Handover offers the child a safe place to meet with their parent or relative at the beginning and end of contact in the community, avoiding any conflict between the adults
