Activity Information & Courses



Run by midwives, there will be 2 sessions. The first covering labour and birth and the second covering breast feeding.

Baby Massage, including GroBrain

Classes delivered by qualified instructors, suitable for babies 6 weeks - 10 months. GroBrain will support you with 'tuning' into baby's cues, cries and providing comfort, using smiles, cuddles and eye contact.

Bilingual Beginnings

Workshops for bilingual families with a child under 5 years, come and meet other parents and find out about the importance of first language when your child is learning English.

Bumps and Babes Storytime

Come along and meet other expectant/new mums and dads, and share stories, songs and rhymes that will help your baby's development. For children under 1 year.

Come Talk with Me

For children aged 2 or 3 years, supporting parents who have concerns with their child's speech and language development.

Introduction to Solids

An opportunity for parents to find out strategies to wean their babies to a milk and food diet, recommended for parents of babies between 4 and 6 months.

Let's Cook in Play and Learn (under 5's)

Sensory session, with food tasting. Ideas for family meals, picnics and lunch boxes. Support with special diets and faddy eaters. Recipes and information to take away.

Midwife appointments Antenatal and Postnatal

Facilitated by Bournemouth Maternity Unit, speak to your midwife to book an appointment.

Parent Forum (children under 5 welcome)

Held twice a year, come and hear our plans for the centre and share your ideas.

Parent Puzzle

A nurturing programme to help parents to develop their parenting skills covering many topics such as why children behave as they do, recognising feelings, approaches to discipline and building cooperation. For parents with a child aged between 2 & 5.

Play and Learn - (under 5's)

Explore activities and new experiences together, designed to support your child's interests, creativity and learning needs. Take away great ideas to try at home too.

Ready, Steady, Go! 1-5 years

To help you support your child to become 'life ready'. With a focus on physical development, confidence, self-esteem, 'school readiness' and improving social skills.
